Heading through Macclesfield you will be directed out on the A523 Leek road. Take the left signposted for Sutton (Byrons Lane) on the edge of Macclesfield and follow this road for about 4 miles. You will come to a T junction with the A54 - it looks like you are going straight on but you need to give way.

Bearing straight on join the A54 and around the corner you will come to crossroads (your right of way); take the right into Wincle.

The driveway to the farm is in the centre of Wincle - it is the last driveway on the right before the Ship Inn, indicated by a sign for Whitelee farm in the stone wall - you will also see a small stable sat just behind this wall in the tree line.

The drive is a mile long and single track for most of the way. You are unlikely to meet anyone on the way. If you do there are passing places.

You will go over 2 cattle grids and then down a steep hill and immediately back up the other side, at this point you are over half way along the drive.

As you travel along a straight part of the drive you will turn to the left to go past a pond, the shepherd huts are visible in a field on your left. Please head through the gateway to that field; there are 2 parking slots just to the right of the gateway on stoned ground. Please do not park on the drive through the field as this is used as farming access to the next field.
